

## Entry Requirements for the CMS

1. The applicant should be a baptised Christian and a member in good standing with his/her church. A letter of recommendation is required from the pastor of the applicant.
2. The applicant must complete and submit the CMS registration form by the closing date on 26 October 2007 together with an initial registration course deposit of \$100.

## Guidelines for course work and grading

1. Students must complete and fulfill all the set module requirements of Parts 1 and 2 within a twelve-month period to obtain the Certificate in Mission Studies.
2. Students must attain GPA 2.0 to graduate.
3. The grading system is similar to that of the degree programme at TTC.
4. A student is allowed to re-sit any examination or re-submit any assigned module requirement within two weeks after the results are announced.
5. The Mission Encounter module is a supervised practicum that must be fulfilled outside the stipulated class-time and may incur additional expenses.
6. Students can choose to audit the courses.

## Transfer Criteria

1. Students may transfer credits from other CDCM courses into the Certificate in Mission Studies and vice-versa upon a successful application.
2. Elective requirements for the Trinity Theological College degree programme of up to four credits may be waived for those who have successfully obtained the Certificate in Mission Studies.
3. As there is no course to course correspondence between the lay training programmes and degree programmes, applicants must complete the former before applying for the latter.

## What is Certificate in Mission Studies?

The Certificate in Mission Studies (CMS) is an intensive eight-module course in cross-cultural ministry.



## The Benefits of CMS

- Become familiar with issues in cross-cultural missions
- Be exposed to practical skills such as worship design and leading
- Be mentored in the discipline of spiritual reflection
- Network with others who are in the ministry
- Experience community life at TTC by living on campus
- Supervised learning opportunities during practicum

## Module Structure

The CMS is made up of two parts.

Each part is in turn made up of four modules.

Part 1 will be held this November (11-23 November 2007)

Part 2 will continue next May (18-30 May 2008)

Each module is equivalent to fifteen hours of class-time spread over three hour sessions daily.

2. Reading the New Testament
3. Understanding Human Cultures
4. Towards a Theology of Mission

Part 2

5. Principles of Biblical Interpretation
6. Proclaiming the Good News in context
7. Transforming the community with the Good News
8. Mission Encounter (Practicum)
