	CCIA Consultation on Peace and Disarmament in Geneva	1962	File	Some 30 persons participated in a Consultation on Peace and Disarmament held in Geneva, Switzerland, June 20-22, 1962, under auspices of the Commission of the Churches on International Affairs, an agency of the World Council of Churches. It was the first such meeting of its kind ever held under WCC sponsorship. Conferees came from Burma, Czechoslovakia, France, Germany, Hungary, India, Netherlands, Poland, the UK, the USA and the USSR. Consultation speakers from the Eighteen-Nations Committee on Disarmament of the United Nations, now in recess, in Geneva were : Mr. Alexander Akalovsky, of the US delegation ; Sir Michael Wright, of the UK delegation ; and Ambassador Semyon Tsarapkin, of the USSR delegation. Baron C. H. von PLaten, of Sweden, interpreted the Joint Memorandum on disarmament of the eight non-aligned nations.
