428.17.06	Inter-regional exchanges on human rights		Series	Correspondence and documentation exchanged with the Asian and Southern African councils on specific initiatives in sharing human rights experiences. A significant effort of exchange between Asian human rights ecumenical partners and churches, on the one hand, and those from Latin America, is documented, with publications ("Behind the Mask") in this section. A first meeting of leaders from both regions was organized in 1982, followed by a lengthy visit and exchange in March and April of 1987 sponsored by the Christian Conference of Asia (CCA), the Latin America Council of Churches (CLAI) and the WCC/HRROLA. Countries visited: the Philippines, Taiwan and the Republic of Korea; Argentina, Chile and El Salvador. A consultation under the sponsorship of the AACC, held in Gaborone, Botswana in May 1987, brought together representatives of the councils of churches of Southern African countries to discuss human rights challenges ("Report on Techniques of Handling Human Rights Abuses") in the sub-region, at which Latin American experiences were shared and documented.
